On the day of the spacing rehearsal on the stage at the **State Theatre (use stage door) (Fri., 05/01)**, **EVERYONE** is required to be there for the **Finale** from **4:00-4:30 pm**. Class and individual photos will be taken at the studio immediately following (or immediately prior) to your scheduled time slot, so everyone should be in **full costume, hair, and make up**. Please arrive and be in costume **a minimum of 30 minutes early**. When your class(es) are finished with tech and photos and your costumes are labeled and put away, you may go home or you are welcome to stay and watch the other classes quietly. We will be holding a bake sale fundraiser to benefit the Children’s Scholarship Program **in the lobby** on Fri., 05/01, during the spacing rehearsal, and prior to the performance on Saturday.

OVER

On the day of the performance (**Sat., 05/02**), **EVERYONE** must be at the **State Theatre** at **8:00 am**. **Enter through the stage door and go directly down to the green room. Quickly get into your first costume, prepare your presets, and sit with your class in the balcony by 8:15 am. Full Dress Rehearsal begins at 8:30 am.** Plan to stay until 11:00 am (pick up at the back door of the studio). Because of an event during the day at the theatre on Saturday, we must tidy up EVERYTHING (down to the green room/chorus dressing rooms). Once everything is put away, we will all go to the studio for notes (what we usually do on the stage). **WE WILL NOT BE HOLDING CLASSES ON SATURDAY SO EVERYONE CAN BE RESTED FOR OUR EVENING PERFORMANCE.**

The Dress Rehearsal on the stage is closed – parents are requested to drop students off at the State Theatre (stage door) and return for pick up at the back door of the studio by 11:00 am. Dancers are due **back to the auditorium by 6:30 PM**. Flowers will be available to purchase in the lobby prior to the performance to give to your special dancer to benefit the Children’s Scholarship Program. **Remember, the Performance on Saturday, May 2nd, begins at 7:30 PM.** Tickets are on sale now at the State Theatre Box Office, 130 West College Avenue, (814) 272-0606, or [www.thestatetheatre.org](http://www.thestatetheatre.org).
